

## Childrens' Program

Micro Music Makers -- *for students who have completed Kindergarten:*

### Period 1

- 1110 Morning Music Instructor: To be announced  
Students will be exposed to variety of musical styles and concepts through rhythm activities and games, singing games, group singing and an introduction to playing pitched and non-pitched percussion instruments. Students will be exploring, interpreting and moving to music.

- 3110 Mini Movement Instructor: To be announced

- 4110 Music Crafts Instructor: Teena Mangan

**Music Makers (for students who have completed Grades 1 or 2)**

- 1120 Music with Tina Instructor: Tina Hebner  
In this creative and movement-oriented class, Mini Music Makers will be developing the listening skills necessary absorb and better understand the music, rhythm and sounds that surround them everyday. Our Mini Music students will be recreating and responding to music, sounds and stories using a variety of pitched and non-pitched instruments along with voice and movement.  
Students will practice rhythm sense, basic note reading, vocal technique, creative expression and musical expression through musical games, rhythm speech, songs and ensemble playing.

## Music Makers (for students who have completed Grades 3 and 4)

### Period 1

- 1140 Orff Instruments Instructor: Jennica Alpaugh  
In this class students will enjoy learning about the Orff instruments. Orff instruments are percussions instruments- think “all different sizes of xylophones” Students will be learning music which they will incorporate into their Musical Theatre production in period 2.

### Period 2

- 2140 Musical Theatre: “*Brought to You By*” Instructor: Jenica Alpaugh

### Period 3

- 3140 Pre- Band Ensemble Instructor: To be announced  
Students will explore the world of the band ensemble. This class is intended as an introduction, and will assist students who may be able to join their school band program in the fall or who may want to take private lessons. While it is not mandatory to have your own instrument it is advisable. We suggest that students check with their school to see if there is an instrument that they can borrow, or you may choose to rent an instrument from a local music store.

### Period 4

- 4140 Music Makers Percussion Ensemble Instructor: Chris Bennett  
This course draws upon various global percussion traditions to reinforce concepts introduced in the core music program. Students will drum, sing, dance and will develop skills pertaining to ensemble awareness, listening, and timekeeping through learning songs and dances of some of the world’s cultural groups.
